

SPECIALS ADJUSTMENT

OR did you think your judge was harder than the others?

BRITISH RIDING CLUBS RULES MAKE THE COMPARISON OF
SCORES FROM ONE ARENA TO ANOTHER AS FAIR AS CAN
BE DONE.
(BRC RULE BOOK 2008 APPENDIX 11)

The rules

1. Calculate the average percentage score for each class.
2. Take the difference between the average of the best scoring class and the average of this class.
3. Add that difference to the percentage for each special in this class.

WHAT YOU SEE

% - Your score as it appears on your sheet

Class Average – The average score for all competitors in this class

Adjustment – The difference between this class average and the best scoring class involving any of this special's competitors.

Effective Score – the result of all this arithmetic and the Score used to find the Special Winner.

Notes:

- 1) If you are in the best scoring class your adjustment will be zero.
- 2) The results will only be complete when the last class involved has finished, until then we can't know the average
